

Encouragement from God's Word "Copies and Shadows" Hebrews 8:3-4

"For every high priest is appointed to offer gifts and sacrifices; thus it is necessary for this priest also to have something to offer.⁴ Now if he were on earth, he would not be a priest at all, since there are priests who offer gifts according to the law.⁵ They serve a copy and shadow of the heavenly things. For when Moses was about to erect the tent, he was instructed by God, saying, "See that you make everything according to the pattern that was shown you on the mountain." (Hebrews 8:3-4)

Sometimes the commands and patterns in God's Word might feel arbitrary to us. Why do we have to do it this way? But this passage in Hebrews reminds us that God set up the Old Covenant tabernacle, priesthood, and system of sacrifice in such a way that it served as a copy and shadow of heavenly things. God doesn't do anything without reason. He is seeking to draw us into heavenly realities. He wants to reveal to us great truths about himself. He wants us to see spiritual truths. So when we read the Old Testament, it might feel dated or irrelevant, but it is not. It is pointing us to deeper, fuller, eternal realities that can never fade.
