

Cabin Request You *MUST* accept the counselor assigned to your cabin. Campers may request one cabin mate and this cabin mate must select you as well. Please do not ask for more than one to be your cabin mate. No request for cabin mates can be assured. Campers may request their parents as counselors if they are assisting in that capacity. ***CAMPERS ARE EXPECTED TO ACCEPT THE ASSIGNMENTS GIVEN THEM WHEN THEY ARRIVE AT CAMP. NO CHANGES PLEASE.***

Camp Activities Camp activities include two hours in Bible classes each day besides the devotional periods in the morning and evening. Other religious activities include singing and devotionals. Sport activities include softball, volleyball, foursquare, hikes, basketball, swimming, fishing, canoeing, and sight seeing tours of the park. Crafts are available to those who are interested. Materials must be purchased by the campers. The camp store will have candy and snacks for sale.

Visitors Sorry, no overnight visitors. Counselors only may invite guests. **Campers are not to invite their friends to visit.** Visitors must check in with the camp director. There will be a charge of \$3.00 for each meal for visitors invited to stay.

Camp Check-Out All campers must be **checked out** of the Camp by **2:00pm** (CST) on Friday of each Camp week. Campers are not allowed to leave camp during camp session without prior written permission.

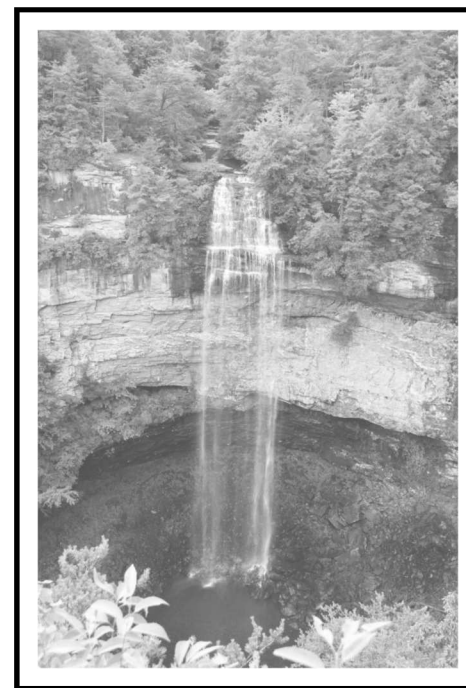
Camp Session

Summer Bible Camp Summer Bible Camp will begin its 63rd session this year in Youth Camp #2; the same area that we occupied in past years. Summer Bible Camp is operated by members of the Church of Christ and directed by Jack James of Ringgold, Georgia, a Minister at the Rossville Congregation, phone 706-937-3847 (home) and 706-866-1119 (church). Below are listed a few facts about the camp.

Location The camp is located in the Fall Creek Falls State Park, about sixteen miles west of Pikeville, off State Highway No. 30.

Ages The ages are ten through nineteen years. Anyone who reaches their tenth birthday on or before the date of camp is eligible. **PLEASE DO NOT ASK FOR EXCEPTIONS.** This camp is open to people of all religious beliefs.

Cost A fee of \$95.00 will be requested for each camper each week. (T-shirts are included with the fee). This fee covers the cost of operation of the camp. An advance payment of the full amount must accompany each application. In the event of cancellation, the fee will be returned upon request of the applicant, provided the request is made at least one week before the camp date.

ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED BY JUNE 8, 2020

Accommodations The rustic cabins are designed to lodge a counselor and seven campers each. The camp only furnishes a bed with a mattress. Campers must furnish bed linen, covers, pillow, and all personal belongings.

Health & Safety First aid supplies will be available. Children will be under adult supervision at all times — both day and night. A life guard will be on duty at the water front at all times when swimming is scheduled. **A signed permit from parents will be required** before their children will be allowed to swim. We expect campers to be covered by a family insurance plan. Please list your policy name and address on the application.
