

Cabin Request: You **MUST** accept the counselor assigned to your cabin. Campers may request one cabin mate and this cabin mate must request you as well. Please do not ask for more than one person to be your cabin mate. No request for cabin mates can be guaranteed. Campers may request their parents as counselor if they are serving in that capacity. **CAMPERS ARE EXPECTED TO ACCEPT THE ASSIGNMENTS GIVEN THEM WHEN THEY ARRIVE AT CAMP. NO CHANGE REQUESTS PLEASE.**

Camp Activities: Camp activities include two hours in Bible classes each day besides the devotional periods in the mornings and evenings. Other religious activities include singing and devotionals. Sports activities include softball, volleyball, hikes, GAGA ball, zip line, low ropes course, disc golf, nine square in the air, archery, archery tag, human foosball, and corn hole. Crafts will be available to those who are interested at an additional cost. The camp store will have candy, snacks, and drinks for sale.

Visitors: All visitors must check-in with the camp director as soon as you arrive. Sorry, but **NO** overnight visitors will be allowed. Due to Covid restrictions in place for camp this year, only family members of campers may visit. **Campers are not to invite their friends to visit.** All visitors are asked to follow the same dress code as campers and counselors. There will be a charge of \$3.00 for each meal the visitors are invited to stay for.

Camp Check-Out: All campers must be checked out of the camp by 2:00 pm CST on Friday of each camp week. Campers are not allowed to leave camp during camp session without prior written permission.

Camp Sessions: *Campers must apply the week of their age group.* The main program will be designed for campers ages 14-19 the first week of camp (June 27 – July 2) and for campers ages 10-13 the second week of camp (July 4 – July 9).

Summer Bible Camp: Summer Bible Camp will begin its 63rd session this year but in a new location, Manderley Christian Camp. Summer Bible Camp is operated by members of the church of Christ and directed by Mark Cagle of Pikeville, TN, a Deacon at Bethel church of Christ. You may contact Mark at 423-718-1582 or coachcagle@gmail.com. A few facts about camp are listed below.

Location: The camp is located in Pikeville, TN, at Manderley Christian Camp. The address for the camp is 100 Manderley Ln, Pikeville, TN 37367.

Accommodations: The cabins are designed to lodge a counselor and six campers each. The camp only furnishes a bed with a mattress. Campers must furnish bed linen, covers, pillow, towels, and all personal belongings. Cabins at Manderley have air conditioners and a ceiling fan, so there is no need to bring a fan for the cabins this year. If you would like to view the accommodations, you may view them at www.manderleycamp.org.

Ages: The ages eligible to attend camp are 10 through 19 years old. Anyone who reaches their 10th birthday on or before the date of camp is eligible. **Please do not ask for exceptions.** This camp is open to people of all religious beliefs.

Cost: A fee of \$125 will be requested for each camper for each week. T-shirts are included with the fee. This fee covers the cost of operation of the camp. An advance payment of the full amount must accompany each application. In the event of cancellation, the fee will be returned upon request of the applicant, provided the request is made at least one week prior to the camp date. **ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED BY JUNE 14, 2021.**

Health and Safety: First aid supplies will be available. Children will be under adult supervision at all times – both day and night. We expect campers to be covered by a family insurance plan. Please list your policy name and address on the application.
