Search The Scriptures Daily

We find an account in Acts chapter 17 that directly applies to us today, in terms of our responsibility as believers. Paul and Silas have spent a few weeks in Thessalonica preaching and teaching in the synagogue. They are faced with serious conflicts with the Jews there, and, after having to flee Thessalonica by night, they end up in a town called Berea, in northern Greece not far from Mount Olympus.

They find the Jewish synagogue in Berea and begin teaching and preaching there. Now listen to what the Word says about the Bereans – "Now these Jews were more noble than those in Thessalonica, for they received the Word with all eagerness, examining the scriptures daily to see if these things were so."

It's not enough just to listen to a powerful, inspiring sermon during our worship service. We are told to make sure those things said from the pulpit can be backed up by book, chapter, and verse, and it's up to each of us to search the scriptures daily.

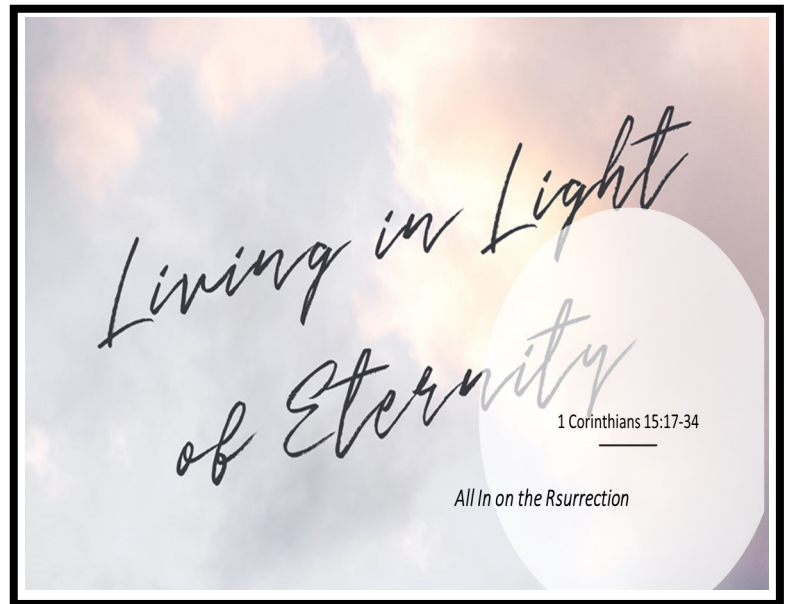
